Terms & Conditions

1. Any appointment which has been broken or cancelled without a 24 hour's notice may have the session fees charged in full.
2. Dogs will not be admitted to the pool without prior authorization of their Veterinarian. Please have your Veterinarian complete the highlighted section on page 1.
3. Dogs with infectious or contagious conditions, such as eye, ear or skin infections will not be able to participate in swimming. In this case owners are advised to cancel all appointments with at least 24 hour's notice, until the condition has cleared normal cancellation conditions would apply.
4. Owners are required to notify Cedar Run Pet Lodge if during swimming the dog's injuries or condition worsens, or if the Veterinarian advises that swimming should be stopped or suspended.
5. Cedar Run Pet Lodge reserves the right to refuse treatment to any dog at anytime.
6. When not swimming all dogs will be kept under control
7. Cedar Run Pet Lodge cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury to any person or animal while on company premises.
8. Bitches in season will not be able to attend sessions until their season has finished this usually last between 7-10 days so she will be ready to return for treatment after 2 weeks unless otherwise advised by your Veterinarian.

9. A surcharge of up to \$200.00 will be made for dogs that defecate in the pool, as we will have to close the pool to clean it. The dog must have bowel control (no diarrhea) and if there are any neurological issues that affect the dog's ability to have bowel control, the owner is responsible for ensuring that the dog has an empty bowel prior to the appointment. We also advise owners not to feed their dog for approximately 2 hours prior and 1 hour after swimming.
10. When visiting Cedar Run Pet Lodge all persons are advised to wear sensible shoes with non-slip soles if possible. The floor in the pool room can become very wet during swimming sessions and it may become slippery.
11. In order to maintain the efficiency of the filtration system and hence the water quality, owners are requested to ensure their dog is fairly clean with trimmed nails prior to swimming.
12. Owners are requested not to exercise their dogs on swim days as this can interfere with progress that he or she makes.
